We are delighted to announce that they have both accepted and will continue to share responsibilities in providing seven-day-a-week, 8 hour/day coverage. Many of you have met Dave and Craig already. They both have a great love for the Lord and the lost, a strong passion for the ministry, and humble, servant hearts. Dave is retired from the U.S. Postal Service and Craig has his own window and house washing business. They work very well together and compliment each other with their gifts and personalities. We sincerely thank the Lord for both of them and have seen His sovereign hand at work in bringing them to us. We ask that you would pray for them and support them as they minister the gospel of Jesus Christ to to both believers and unbelievers through Carlisle Truck Stop Ministry, Inc.
